

Membership Programme Regulations of Design Society at Shenzhen Sea World Culture and Arts Center

Before applying for the membership programme of Design Society at Shenzhen Sea World Culture and Arts Center, please read and follow the "Membership Service Regulations of Design Society of Shenzhen Sea World Culture and Arts Center". Any person who buys or uses membership services is considered to have read and accepted the above terms.

I. Notice

This Regulations aim to clarify the rights and obligations between Design Society of Shenzhen Sea World Culture and Arts Center (hereinafter referred to as "Design Society" and its members. The applicant can become a member of Design Society only after he or she agrees to all the terms of this Regulations with signature. Design Society will provide the required services and take the responsibilities as described in the Regulations below.

II. General Provisions

- a. The Design Society Membership Card (hereinafter referred to as "Membership Card"), sold publicly by Design Society, gives the cardholder certain rights.
- b. The Membership Cards are sold to natural persons. The membership settlement is charged in RMB.

III. Membership Management

- a. An applicant can become a member only after truthfully filling out the membership application form and successfully settling the payment.
- b. When applying for a membership card for the first time, the applicant shall submit the relevant documents required by Design Society, fill out the application form correctly, completely and truthfully according to the rules of Design Society Membership Programme. The applicant agrees and authorizes Design Society to access its information system to retain relevant information.
- c. Real name registration: Membership Card applicants need to register their real names. The name cannot be changed once the registration is activated. Design Society has the right to obtain, retain and use the personal information of applicants, and also to decide whether to issue the membership cards.
- d. Design Society accepts its members to use physical membership cards or an electronic ones.
- e. The safekeeping, loss report and reapplication of the Membership Card: The cardholder shall take good care of the membership card. If a membership card is lost, the cardholder should go to Design Society to report as soon as possible. The cost of a membership card

is 50 yuan. The membership card does not need a password in principle. The electronic records of transactions such as discounts and service offers conducted by using the membership card are all valid proofs of the corresponding transactions. These transactions are deemed to have been made with the consent of the member or by the member. Any losses, such as information leakage, card loss, damage and unauthorized use, caused by improper storage of the membership card or by delayed loss report will be borne by the member, Design Society is not liable.

- f. The membership card cannot be leased, transferred or lent. Any consequences arising from the lease, transfer or lending of the membership card shall be borne by the member.
- g. When there is a change in address, phone number, e-mail address or identity information, the member should promptly contact Design Society to handle the information change procedures. Otherwise, the resulting loss will be borne by the member.
- h. The Design Society membership is valid for a year. Members can check their membership validity in the "Member Information" section of the Design Society website or in the "Member Zone" of the Design Society WeChat account. To protect the rights of members, Design Society will send reminders to members before the expiration of their membership. When the Design Society membership is expired, the member needs to renew his or her membership card or reapply for membership before he or she enjoys member rights and benefits.

IV. Membership Programme Fulfillment, Agreement, Changes, Interruptions or Termination

- a. Members shall comply with the relevant State laws and regulations and the rules of the Company, and shall not use the service for any unlawful purpose.
- b. When providing services, Design Society has the right to require members to show their membership cards or ID cards so as to confirm that the membership card is used by the cardholder.
- c. Before applying for membership, applicants should fully understand all kinds of services provided by Design Society and voluntarily purchase the services. After the membership card is sold and signed by the applicant, Design Society will not accept any membership withdrawal or refund application.
- d. For service changes, interruptions or terminations caused by force majeure, Design Society has no need to be responsible to members or any third party.

V. Content Ownership

The Company's services include (but not limited to) text, diagrams, software, formulas, sounds, pictures, videos, etc. All the content and all the rights and interests belong to the Company and

are protected by copyright, trademark and other property ownership laws. Members can use the content only after being authorized by the Company or other relevant content owners, and cannot copy or redevelop the content, or create derivatives related to the content.

VI. Privacy Protection

- a. Design Society promises not to disclose the member registration information or the personal privacy information stored in the Company to the public nor to any third party unless under the following circumstances: Services to be provided to members by Design Society and its partners, authorization obtained before information disclosure, information disclosure according to laws and regulations, or for protecting the legitimate rights and interests of the Company and its members.
- b. Design Society has the right to analyze the entire membership database for business needs and to use the database for commercial purpose.

VII. Disclaimer

- a. Because certain service resources are special and scare, Design Society does not guarantee that these services will meet the requirements of its members.
- b. If services cannot be provided due to system failure caused by force majeure, Design Society shall not bear any resulting losses.
- c. For costs and responsibilities arising from disputes between members and Design Society's partners, Design Society will help members to communicate and coordinate. However, Design Society shall not cover any costs nor take any responsibilities.

VIII. Supplementary Provisions

- a. Design Society reserves the right to have the final interpretation of the Regulations.
- b. If Design Society and its members have any dispute over the content or the implementation of this Regulations, both parties should resolve issues through friendly negotiation. When the negotiation fails, either party can institute legal proceedings in the people's court where Design Society is located.
